## DIRECTOR'S NOTE

Welcome to the 2016 Spring Dance Concert in the newly renamed Tedford Main Stage. Earlier this semester, the Department of Theatre and Dance honored longtime emeritus theatre professor Dr. Harold Tedford for his tremendous dedication to our department and the life of the arts at Wake Forest. The dance program is honored to share in this legacy and perform on your stage, Dr. T. Thank you for your inspiring leadership and passion!

This has been an incredibly exciting year for our dance program. Earlier this year as part of the Secret Artist Series, we welcomed dance visionary Larry Keigwin and his Company on stage and in class with our students as part of the Secret Artist Series. Helen Simoneau Danse provided open rehearsals for the Winston-Salem community and taught classes to our students during her residency at the Hanesbrands Theatre downtown. MacArthur award winning choreographer Liz Lerman kicked off the Aging Re-Imagined symposium I organized with colleagues on this campus and the medical campus to talk about the ways the arts and sciences can work together in research and teaching. During that symposium, my colleagues traveled with select students to West Virginia University to attend and teach at the American College Dance Association conference. Here, senior dance minor Rae Bradley presented her choreography among student and faculty choreographers from universities throughout the mid-Atlantic. As you read this, our fabulous new colleague Jessie Laurita-Spanglet is in Washington, D.C. with eight of our students who are performing in an evening of her work at the Kennedy Center's Millennium Stage. Finally, after this concert closes, over 120 children in our Community Ballet program, led by Brantly Shapiro and assisted by dance company members Emilie Bogusz and Lauren Chuang, will perform on May 7th. It's hard to believe but this marks the 32nd year of our successful Community Ballet program.

I am so proud to be a member of this robust dance community and am honored to assume the director of dance position this summer as Nina Lucas becomes chair of the Department of Theatre and Dance. On behalf of the faculty, staff and students in the dance program, I want to congratulate Nina on her new role and thank her for her twenty years of service as Dance Director. A special thank you also to J.K. Curry for guiding our department for the last seven years as chair.

I hope you will enjoy this performance as we celebrate the strong work of 10 student choreographers and over 50 WFU dance company dancers. We are so proud of their work and dedication to our program. Thank you for coming and for your continued support of the WFU Dance Company.
